

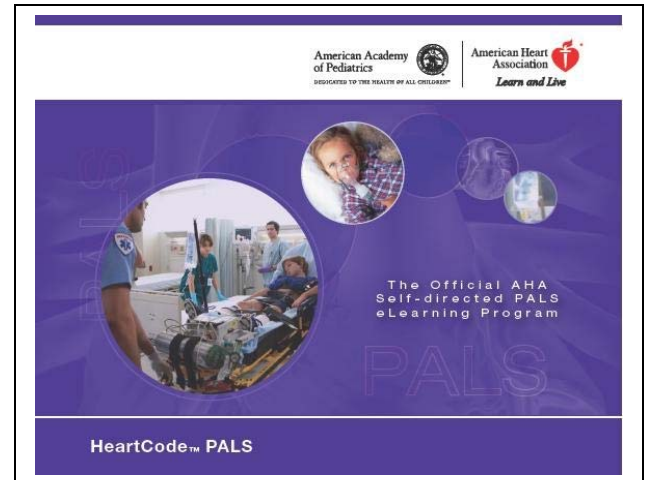

Course Description:

HeartCode PALS Part 1 is a self-directed, interactive, CD-based product that uses eSimulation technology to present 12 interactive, realistic hospital-based, pediatric patient cases that teach healthcare providers to evaluate and manage seriously ill infants and children.

Interacting with the program, students assess each patient, formulate a treatment plan based on the PALS algorithm and the 2005 *AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC*, and provide treatment in a virtual setting. Students who successfully complete the cognitive component (part 1 CD), followed by successful skills practice and testing (parts 2 and 3) with a PALS Instructor receive an AHA PALS Provider course completion card.

HeartCode PALS Part 1 is approved for Continuing Education Credit for nurses and emergency medical services personnel.
